1. General provisions

All rates are stated in Norwegian kroner (NOK) exclusive value added tax (VAT). For information on commercial terms and conditions, and provisions concerning these tariffs, see “Commercial terms and conditions for use of infrastructure and services provided by the Port of Tromsø”, which is published on www.tromso.havn.no

A separate tariff document applies for charges for quays and services in connection with cruise calls.

3. Maritime infrastructure

3.1 Fairway dues

The minimum rate per call is NOK 383. Fairway dues are calculated based on gross tonnage (GT).

The Port of Tromsø has been instructed by the Norwegian Coastal Administration to set this fee to NOK 0, until overcharged fees are reimbursed to the users. Consequently, in practical terms, vessels calling at quays in the municipality's sea area will not be charged fairway dues in 2024. This will be shown by stipulating the fairway dues as NOK 0 in invoices issued by the Port of Tromsø.

3.2 Quay charges

Minimum rate for quay charges per 24-hour period

The table above applies to commercial vessels. For recreational vessels, the table in [Section 3.4](#) below applies.

Quay charges are calculated based on gross tonnage (GT) and are differentiated according to vessel type.

The quay charges normally cover the area the ship needs for gangways, provisions for own consumption and minor logistics, etc. For major equipment changes, special loading operations, mobilisation projects, etc. rental of the area for these purposes will be invoiced separately.

Separate rates apply for special projects and calls involving larger projects, e.g. rigs, fleet visits, etc. Please contact us for a specific offer.

3.3 Discount structure

Type of discount	Scope of discount
Commercial vessels under 15 metres with a laytime exceeding 1 week. The discount applies from the eighth day.	20% of quay charges
Commercial vessels over 15 metres with a laytime of 1-2 months. The discount applies from the first day.	10% of quay charges
Commercial vessels over 15 metres with a laytime exceeding 2 months. The discount applies from the first day.	20% of quay charges
Vessels with regular and high frequency of calls	Assessed on a case-by-case basis and must be requested by the shipping company/vessel.

Conditions for granting discounts vary from case to case and may consist of requirements related to shore power, portability, etc. All discounts must be requested prior to the call.

The minimum rate for the respective size category applies independently and regardless.

3.4 Charges for small-craft berths and guest marinas

Floating piers at guest marina – recreational vessels

Quay charges (paid by app) include electricity, water and waste disposal. Customers who are unable to use the app may pay via a mobile card terminal by contacting the Port Control. However, this will incur an additional charge for one hour's work, cf. [Section 5.2](#).

Long-term rental (winter storage, excluding electricity). Only applies to recreational vessels in the period from 15 September to 15 May:

Long-term rental – charter boats at Marina South/Charter pier over 5 months:

3.5 Waste disposal fee and charges

Vessels ordering waste disposal services (e.g. container and sewage vacuum truck) will be invoiced the actual costs in addition to a 20% administrative charge (maximum NOK 12,000).

Vessels delivering waste to fixed recycling stations will be invoiced a fixed waste based of the GT of the vessel. This covers up to 1-1.5 m³ waste.

3.6 Security (ISPS) charges

Calls to ISPS-approved quay

The security charge is levied at a rate of 30% of the quay charges per day. The actual costs of security arrangements are charged in addition.

General

The vessel will be invoiced for any additional costs incurred due to changes in arrival or departure times made less than 24 hours before the notified time of arrival.

During normal operation with security level 1, the security charge will be levied in accordance with the Port tariffs. During situations where the security level is raised, the vessel shall cover any additional costs for measures necessitated by the port call.

In situations where an ISPS vessel and a non-ISPS vessel must be docked at the same quay, the Port of Tromsø may order the use of security guards at the expense of one or both vessels.

If security is required at ISPS vessels, the security guards must be ordered through the Port of Tromsø.

3.7 Passenger fees

Passenger fees are charged for vessels and vehicles in passenger traffic. The fee applies to both embarking and disembarking passengers, as well as passengers using Tromsø Havn KF's facilities.

This fee does not apply to passengers with Kystruten, express boats and scheduled buses.

4. Use of land-based infrastructure

4.1 Charges for land-based transport

Vehicle charges

Vehicle charges are levied for driving into all the Port of Tromsø's roads, terminals and quays.

Different arrangements and rates apply depending on the type of traffic and frequency. Separate agreements apply for operators that have a fixed address and/or traffic that does not pass through areas with restricted access.

For special logistics projects, a fixed amount may be agreed for vehicle charges.

4.2 Charges for area rental

Agreed rental of quay areas and logistics areas normally lasts for up to four weeks. For rental over four weeks, consideration will be given to entering into separate rental agreements.

The Port of Tromsø must be notified (via the Port Control) on commencement and completion of work.

5. Services

5.1 General for all services

Services are activities which the port performs on behalf of and for our customers.

- Rental of equipment and labour are included in sale of services.
- No vehicles, machinery or boats are rented without operator/driver, and the stated rates are inclusive operator/driver.
- A minimum rental period of two hours applies for operations outside regular working hours. Refer to the relevant service for the minimum period within regular working hours.
- Services that the Port of Tromsø can deliver must initially be ordered from us. The exception is if we do not have the capacity to deliver the service, external actors and/or terminal operators can be requested. In special cases, operations or projects, deviations from this point may be considered.
- For certain projects and long-lasting operations, separate rates may be set by agreement.

Working hours at the Port of Tromsø

The standard rates apply during normal working hours for employees at the Port of Tromsø:

- 15 May – 14 September, Monday-Friday, 08:00-15:00
- 15 September – 14 May, Monday-Friday, 08:00-15:45

A surcharge over and above the regular rates is based on the working hours and is 50%, 100% or 133% (public holidays).

5.2 Labour

Standard rates apply during normal working hours for employees at the Port of Tromsø:

Standard rates apply during regular working hours for staff at the Port of Tromsø:

The Port of Tromsø has a limited range of cables and we assume that vessels will generally have their own cables. Adapters may be borrowed free of charge.

5.5 Wheel loader and forklift

The minimum rental period during regular working hours is one hour. However, outside regular working hours, a minimum of two hours will be invoiced.

5.6 Work boat

The work boat is 10.5 m long and has a cargo deck and adjustable bow hatch, but no crane. Maximum load capacity: 1.5 tonnes depending on the nature of the cargo.

- The minimum rental period during regular working hours is one hour. However, outside regular working hours, a minimum of three hours will be invoiced.
- When hiring the work boat services, crew from the Port of Tromsø is used (Section 5.2), unless otherwise is agreed in advance.

5.7 Reach stackers

Reach stackers: 2 x Kalmar Reach Stacker are in the logistics area at quay 24-25 at Breivika and at Grøtsund. Capacity: 45 tonnes.

- The minimum period for hire of reach stacker services is one hour within regular working hours and two hours outside regular working hours.
- In cases where the load has not been prepared with legal lifting devices, the time until this has been rectified will be invoiced in accordance with the tariffs.
- In addition to an operator, a signal man from the Port of Tromsø will be used for all operations involving a reach stacker (Section 5.2), unless otherwise arranged in advance.

5.8 Fenders

Rental of Yokohama fenders: Diameter 2.0 metres, length 3.5 metres. The Port of Tromsø currently has eight fenders available.

The Port of Tromsø's fenders must be used at the Port of Tromsø's quays, unless otherwise agreed.

The use of external fenders is not technically possible at all quays. Please contact the Port Control for further information.
