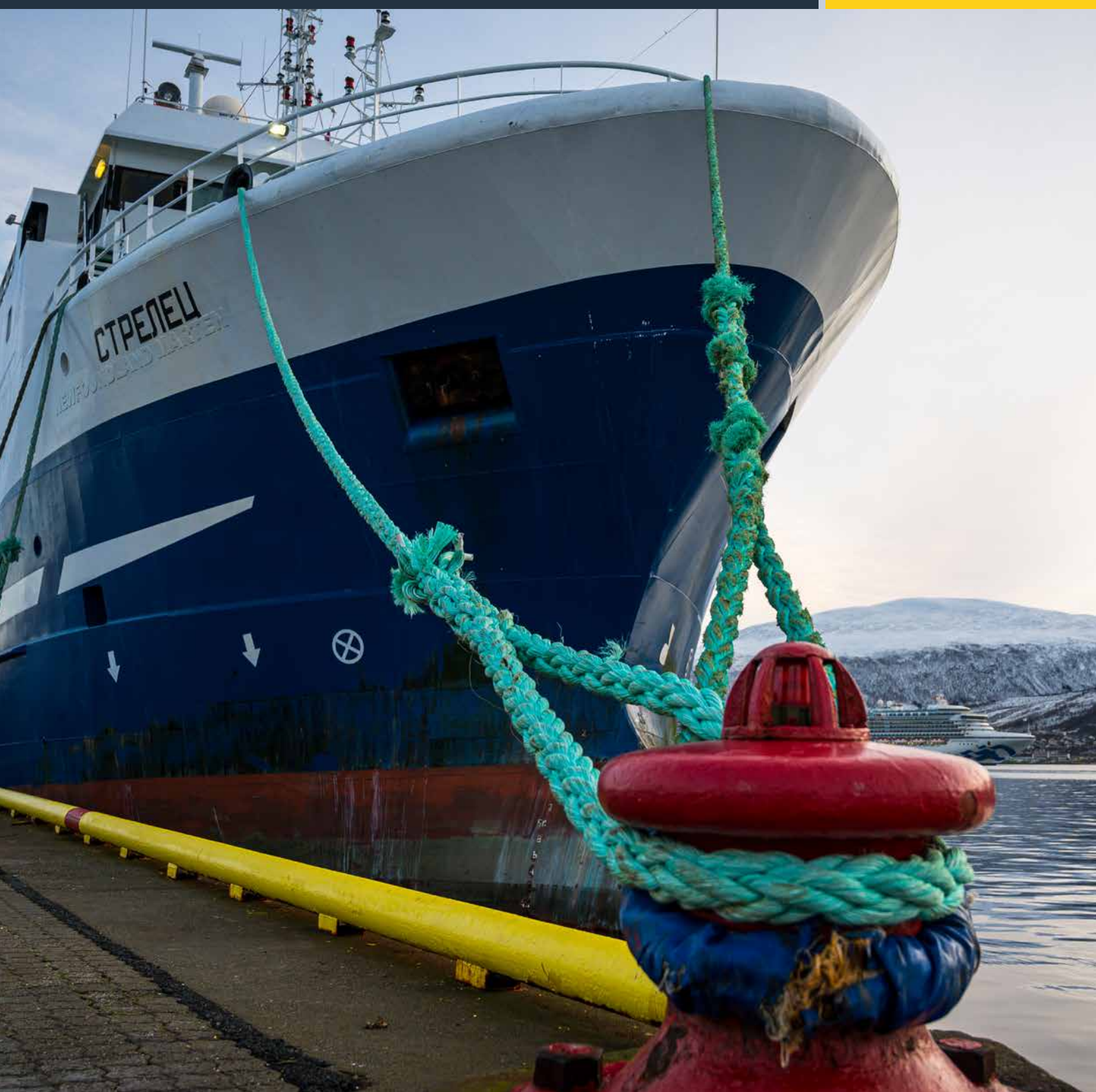

Port of Tromsø

The Port of Tromsø is owned by the municipality of Tromsø. Our mission is to contribute to development of maritime business activities in the municipality and to handle administrative tasks Tromsø has been assigned to in accordance to the Norwegian Act relating to harbours and fairways.

The Port of Tromsø is Norway's largest fishing port, an important cruise port and the largest logistics hub in Northern Norway. In addition we experience a growing activity related to energy and heavy industries.

Surrounded by mountains Tromsø enjoys stable weather conditions and has a sheltered port. The port is always ice-free.

The Port of Tromsø has three major port areas; Prostneset (City centre), Breivika and Grøtsund.

Ocean industries

Fishery

The strategic location to fishing fields in the Norwegian Sea and Barents Sea has made Tromsø the largest Fishing port in Norway. Tromsø have several cold Storage warehouses with high capacity. A number of businesses serving the fishing fleet make Tromsø a highly efficient port.

Logistic

Tromsø is the main logistic hub in Northern Norway, and several logistic operators have storages and warehouses in the port area. A large number of containers are daily transported between Tromsø and national and international destinations.

Tourism

Tromsø is a popular tourist destination and welcomes cruise ships all year round. The high capacity of hotel rooms and frequent flights, make Tromsø ideal for turnaround operations for small and medium size cruise ships.

Energy

The Port of Tromsø has a large logistic area with a deep water quay. This, combined with the local service industry and strategic location in relation to energy in the arctic region, makes Tromsø attractive for heavy industry projects.

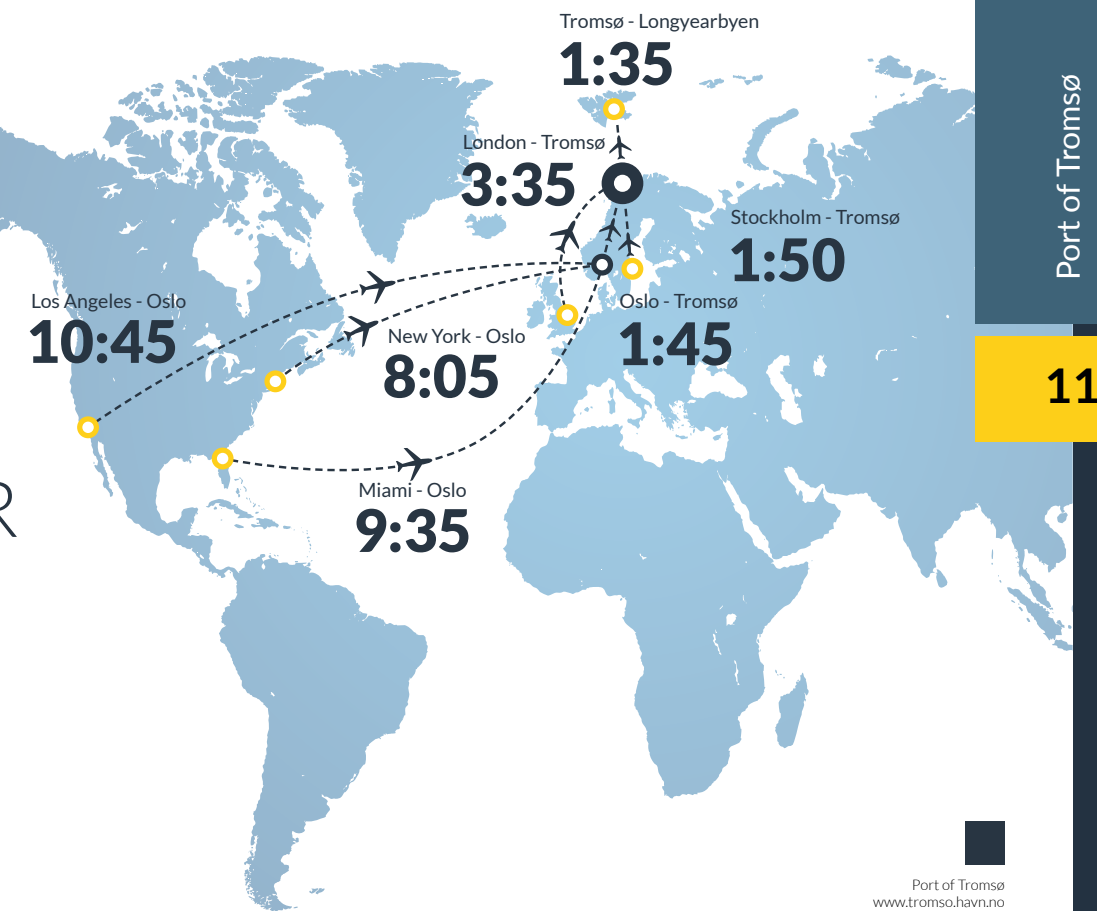

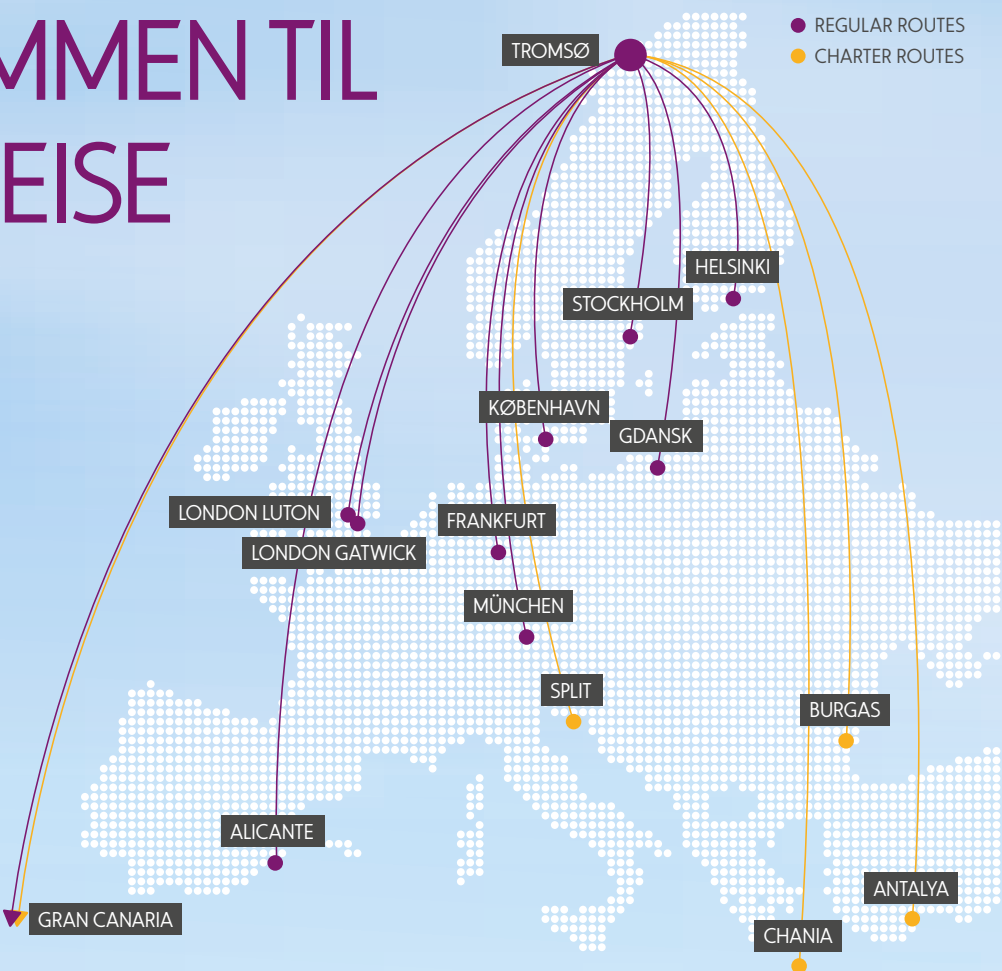

Corporate Social Responsibility

The Port of Tromsø has an ambitious vision; *Creating the arctic future.*

To bring the organisation in the right direction we have defined three main strategies:

1. Facilitate maritime business development

The Port of Tromsø shall be an active business development partner and contribute to increased activities in the port areas. To do this we need to continue to develop our areas and port-related services.

2. Be a driving force for the green maritime shift in the north

The Port of Tromsø shall reduce emissions from port operations. We shall be a pioneer in waste management and be an environmental advocate in the maritime value chain. Furthermore, the Port of Tromsø will aim to move cargo from wheel to keel.

3. Be engaged, effective and willing to change

We shall continue to develop a customer-oriented organization, ensure efficient operation and economic strength for future development. The Port of Tromsø shall have a socially responsible business operation and be transparent.

Our aim is to contribute to a balanced economic, social and environmental development of the society we are a part of.



Health, security and environment

The Port of Tromsø makes continual efforts to create a safe and secure workplace for our employees and our partners. Our overall goal is zero harm to humans. Some of the security procedures in place at the Port of Tromsø are:

- Access control. All companies permitted to enter the ISPS-approved port facilities must complete security declarations and ID cards, that must be approved by the Port of Tromsø. Vehicles must have special permits issued by the Port of Tromsø. All ships must notify the Port of Tromsø 24 hours prior to their estimated time of arrival. They must also notify the port on departure.

- Security inspections are conducted on cargo.
- Fencing and gates are installed to prevent unauthorized access to ISPS-approved port facilities. Own project dedicated fencing of areas can be provided on request.
- 24-hour surveillance. Security patrols and camera monitoring of the ISPS-approved port facilities to prevent and detect illegal entry to these facilities.

The Port of Tromsø works systematically on understanding and managing risk, in order to detect weaknesses and to assess the level of security.
